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## JAMESTOWNE VISITATION

In accordance with Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), in conjunction with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), visitation is open to all residents and their guests. Although there will be no further limitations on visitation, visits must be conducted in a manner that adheres to the core principles of COVID-19 infection prevention and does not increase risk to other residents.

- Visitors who have a positive viral test for COVID-19, symptoms of COVID-19, or currently meet the criteria for quarantine, should NOT enter the facility.
- All visitors should continue to screen in at the main entrance.
- Please practice proper hand hygiene (use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred).
- Regardless of vaccination status, visitors must wear a face covering or mask, maintain physical distance of at least six feet between people, and practice proper hand hygiene.
- Please read instructional signage posted throughout the facility and be aware of COVID-19 signs and symptoms and infection control precautions.
- Visitors should limit movement in the facility and go directly to the resident's room or designated visitation area.
